The World Angus Secretariat was established in 1969 to facilitate the sharing of information between the various Angus Societies/Associations of the world. The Secretariat has established a Code of Practice which includes, inter alia, protocols for the maintenance of genetic purity and exchange of genetic information. Members of the World Angus Secretariat are the recognised authority on the purity of the Angus genetics in their country.
